Downtown State College Parking Guide

Surface Parking Lots

- The rate is \$0.75 per hour. Meters accept quarters, dimes and nickels.
- Meters are enforced Monday through Saturday from 8am until 10pm.
- All municipal meters are free on Thursdays after 6pm and all day Sunday
- **Beaver Avenue Lot** - 100 W. Beaver Ave.
 - 3 hour parking meters
- **Allen Street Parking Lot** – 200 block of S. Allen Street (access from D Alley)
 - 5 hour parking meters
- **Fraser Street Parking Lot** - 100 Fraser Street
 - 3 hour parking meters
- **McAllister Parking Deck** - on 100 McAllister Street.
 - 3 and 5 hour meters
 - The 2nd level of the parking deck is reserved for monthly rentals Monday through Friday from 7:30am to 5:30pm.
 - There is no overnight parking in the deck on Sunday's from 3am-6am.

On-Street Meters

- Most on-street meters have a 2-hour or less time limit.
- The rate is \$1.00 per hour. Meters accept quarters, dimes and nickels.
- Meters are enforced Monday through Saturday from 8am to 6pm.

Parking Garages

- Municipal garages are located on 200 West Beaver Avenue, 100 South Fraser Street and 100 South Pugh Street. The rate is \$0.75 per hour.

- An Attendant is on duty most hours.
- The reduced overnight parking rate is \$0.50 per hour from 10pm until 6am.
- Sunday's are free except for event weekends.
- *Event rates are \$1.25 per hour, maximum charge for 24 hours is \$24.*

Monthly Rentals

- Monthly rental permits for non-reserved parking are offered in all three garages, McAllister Deck, and Allen Street Surface Lot. Reserved parking is available in the Sparks Street Lot.
- On-street commuter permits are available at a cost of \$40 per month.

Two Hassle-Free Parking Options!

- CashKey works in all municipal meters. Park without coins!
- EZ Card allows cash-free parking in the parking garages. No more waiting in line to pay every time you park!

Handicapped Parking

- Handicapped parking spaces are available in all off-street municipal parking facilities.
- It is illegal to park in a handicapped space without a plate or placard. The minimum fine is \$50. Please assist our handicapped citizens and visitors by not using these spaces.

Merchant Validations

- Several downtown merchants validate parking in the municipal garages. Contact Downtown Improvement District at 814-238-7004 for a list of participating merchants.
